2012 ~ Scholarship information from the Memorials Committee:

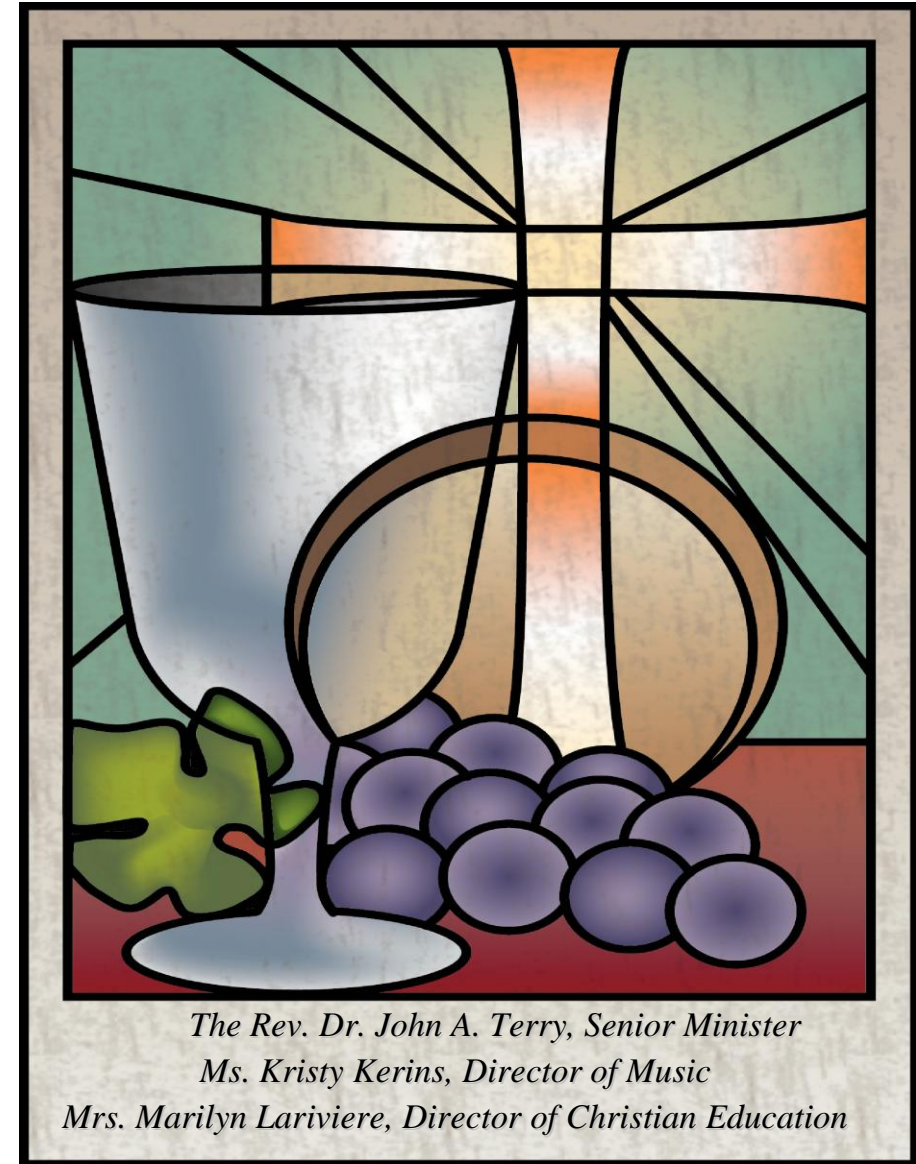
