2. August 18, 2019. (Exodus 15:20-21, Numbers 12:1-15)

—**Miriam**, a prophet and spiritual leader, sister of Aaron and Moses.

3. August 25, 2019. (2 Kings 5:1-27)

—**The Maid of Naaman's Wife**, a foreigner and a servant who offers helpful counsel to her employer.
