### *"THE CONCERT SERIES AT 320 MAIN"*

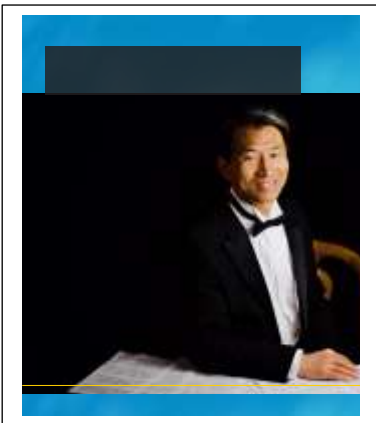
The Federated Church of Hyannis continues to host a concert series which began June 23<sup>rd</sup> and runs through October. Below is a preliminary list of what's to come:
