# Women of Grace and Courage

Our summer sermon series explores the journeys of six women in the Bible, some may be new to you. These women of courage and grace, are prophets, leaders, advocates for justice and righteousness. Some even had to break with tradition to remain faithful to God's promises. Their names may not be familiar, but their stories are woven deeply into God's plan to reconcile the world unto God's self.

1. July 21, 2019 (1 Samuel 25:2-27)

—**Abigail** acted with determination and wisdom to diffuse a volatile situation.

2. July 28, 2019 (Esther 1:1-21)

—**Vashti** although she disappears quite early in the story for refusing to show herself to the king and his drunken friends, her influence is noticeable throughout the rest of the Book.

3. August 4, 2019 (2 Samuel 21:1-14)

—**Rizpah**, her actions speak louder than words. Although voiceless and powerless, she reminds the national leader, king David that God requires mercy, justice and humility from humanity.

4. August 11, 2019 (2 Kings 22:14-20, 2 Chronicles 34:22-33)

—**Huldah**, a prophet who was well respected for her leadership abilities.

5. August 18, 2019. (Exodus 15:20-21, Numbers 12:1-15)

—**Miriam**, a prophet and spiritual leader, sister of Aaron and Moses.

6. August 25, 2019. (2 Kings 5:1-27)

—**The Maid of Naaman's Wife**, a foreigner and a servant who offers helpful counsel to her employer.
