25th Annual Hyannis Father's Day Car Show Sunday- June 16, 2019:

If you are thinking about attending the **25th** annual Father's Day Car Show on Main Street, Hyannis- June 16th, it is close to being filled up. As of Thursday, 318 cars had pre-registered and we can only accommodate about 350.

Pre-registration closed on Friday in order to get the registration packets out in the mail to pre-registered vehicles by June 7th. However, there may be spaces left, so give the Chamber a call- 508-775-7778 on **Monday** to see if you can **stop in** at the Chamber office at 256 South Street, Hyannis- across from the Catholic church, and register and pay.

I will be at the day-of registration (same spot) at the corner of North Street and High School Rd. about 6:30 AM. Look for my Red Raptor pick up in the parking lot. If there are still some spaces open, I will take applications (see below) on a first come, first served basis. Show cars must be parked on Main Street by 8:30 AM and any day-of registrants could be able to gain access by 9:00 AM.
