Thank you for your continued support of our Church's missions.

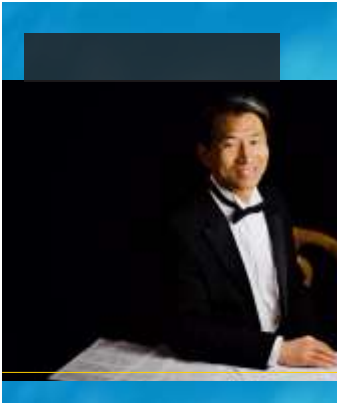
